Cleveland Waterfalls

Saturday April 5th.

This will be mostly long exposure type shooting. For this you will need a tripod, remote trigger, and ND filter. A 6 stop is the most useful. If you don't have any ND filters, I have about 10 that you can use. My filters are mostly 77mm filter size. If your lens has a smaller filter size, you can purchase a step ring that will go from your size to 77mm. As to lens selection, I have used 24-105 and 70-200 in the past.

If you are new to Long Exposure shooting, you can download the eBook or PDF version of my book on Long Exposure. It is on the camera club website under education.

The various locations will require walking from the parking lot to the fall's location. They are not very far, but can involve either many steps or unimproved trails up and down a hill. Also remember, this is spring, so paths and trails can be muddy.

In that there are not a lot of good lunch options in this area, I have always brought lunch with me for lunch break at the Viaduct Park (stop #2)

You should plan to arrive at Brandywine Falls around 9:00 am .

1 ½ hour shooting

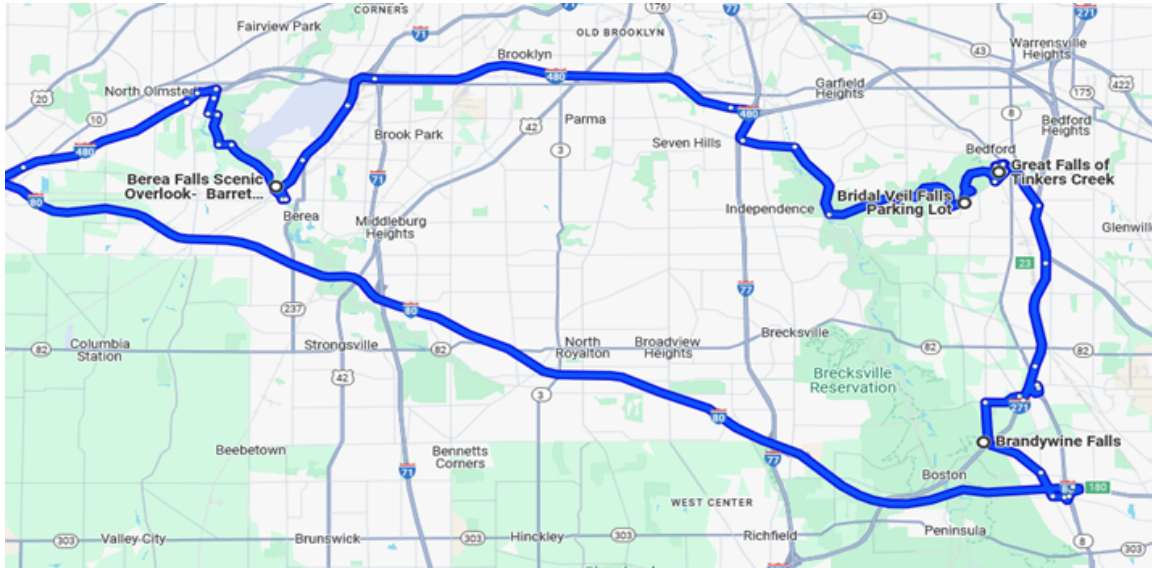
Berea Falls Scenic Overlook- Barret Overlook

40 minutes' drive from Bridal Veil Falls

1 ½ Hours shooting

Head home from here. Around 3 hours home.



General notes about this trip

To reach each of the waterfalls, will involve a short walk, but will have either hills or stairs. As this is spring, trails can be wet and muddy.

Map shows a route that includes the Ohio Turnpike. Toll each way is \$11.25 without EZpass.

One option instead of driving over on the morning of April 5th, drive over on Friday evening and spend the night about 40 minutes from our first location. When I have done this in the past, I stay at a Comfort Inn that is near the airport. About \$100 -\$120 with tax.
